Young Achievers Program

Updated 2024

Guidelines

- The Young Achievers Program ('Program') is being run by the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters, 175 The Parade, Norwood SA 5067 (ABN 11390194824) ('the Council').
- The Program will be run from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025 ('Funding Year'). 2.
- Applications for the Program must be made by submitting the Young Achievers Program Application Form to the Council no earlier than three (3) months and no later than two (2) weeks prior to the event, competition or leadership development program. The event, competition or leadership development program must occur within the Funding Year.
- Applicants can only make one (1) application per Funding Year.

Eligibility Criteria

- 5. To be eligible for funding under this Program, the applicant must be:
 - aged 10–18 years old at the time of the event, competition or program;
 - a resident of the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters; and
 - · selected as a representative of the state or country in a sport, academic or art competition or event, or be participating in a leadership development program approved by the Council (e.g. YMCA Youth Parliament, Duke of Edinburgh Award Australia and other programs approved by the Council on a case-by-case basis).
- The applicant must provide the Council with a copy of a letter from the relevant body or peak organisation verifying the applicant's selection in the competition or event, or enrolment in the program, together with their application form for the Program.

Funding

- 7. The following funding is available under the Program per applicant, per Funding Year:
 - \$150 for an event or competition in South Australia;
 - \$250 for an interstate event or competition;
 - \$500 for an international event or competition; and
 - \$350 for participation in an approved development program ('Funding').
- The Funding provided to an applicant will be no greater than the total cost paid for the event or program by the applicant.
- Funding is not available to individuals who receive individual or club sponsorship.

Selection of recipients

- 10. The total number of applicants that are selected to receive Funding in a Funding Year will be subject to Council budget availability.
- 11. If more than five (5) applications are received from the same team, a maximum amount of \$1000 will be allocated to the team and not the individuals.
- 12. Successful applicants will be notified within fourteen (14) days of their application and funds will be transferred to the applicant's bank account in accordance with the details provided in the Application Form within three (3) weeks of notification.

General

- 13. If for any reason the Program is not capable of running as planned, the Council reserves the right to cancel, terminate, suspend or modify the Program.
- 14. Successful applicants will be required to submit to the Council a 200 word summary and an electronic photo of their experience at the event, competition or leadership program no later than one (1) month after the conclusion of the event, competition or program.
- 15. The applicant agrees that they provide unconditional consent to the Council to use their name, image, photographs and written summary for publicity and promotional purposes in connection with the Program without compensation, and agrees that the Council will own the copyright of any such images, photographs and written material and in all material incorporating the photographs or written material for an unlimited period of time without further notification, remuneration or compensation for the purpose of promoting, publicising or marketing the Program.
