

3.2 APPOINTMENTS TO THE BUSINESS & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Cr Knoblauch moved:

That pursuant to Section 90(2) and (3) of the Local Government Act 1999 the Council orders that the public, with the exception of the Council staff present [Chief Executive Officer, General Manager, Governance & Civic Affairs, Manager, Chief Executive's Office, Manager, Governance & Legal, Manager, Communications & Community Relations, Manager, Economic Development & Strategy and Executive Assistant, Governance & Civic Affairs], be excluded from the meeting on the basis that the Council will receive, discuss and consider:

- a. Information the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)*

and the Council is satisfied that, in principle that the meeting should be conducted in a place open to the public, has been outweighed by the need to keep the receipt/discussions/consideration of the information confidential.
